# POLICY NO. 6-4A

# SUPPLEMENTAL RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATE: SCHEDULE B

## **PURPOSE OF POLICY:**

To define supplemental residential service rate class and establish electric rates for that class.

#### POLICY CONTENT:

Applicability of Supplemental Residential Service Rate Schedule

- 1. Electric service is required by a member served under a residential rate for purposes supplemental to the service received under Schedule A and no more than 500 kWh's per month on average are used.
- 2. Examples to apply this rate include, but are not limited to, workshops, sheds, barns, memberowned lighting, pumps and docks.
- **3.** Locations under this rate cannot be used for residential living or commercial purposes, must be located on the same legal parcel as the residential account, share a common transformer and are supplemental to and must remain the responsibility of the same member.

#### Net Supplemental Residential Service Monthly Rates:

Service Availability Charge – Single Phase:

\$14.87 per month (one half of the residential rate in Policy 6-4)\$0.0694 per kWh
