INDUSTRIAL RATE SCHEDULE: SCHEDULE C-3

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

To define and establish the industrial rate class and rate.

POLICY CONTENT:

Applicability of Industrial Rate Schedule

The industrial rate schedule applies to all services where maximum demand is greater than 2,000 kW, except for loads designated as new large single loads.

<u>Determination of rates for qualifying loads</u>

Each member qualifying for this rate schedule will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis to determine the rate to be charged. Rates will be based on the cost to serve the load, the expected revenue from the load and the financial impact to the general membership.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION:

The board of trustees is responsible for establishing rates for each individual member in this rate class. The CEO is responsible for recommending rates to the board which will allow cost recovery and meet market conditions and for developing procedures to bill qualifying members under this rate schedule. The board shall approve any agreed to rate.
